

IDDL-2 CERTIFICATE (TENTATIVE COURSE GUIDE)

Pre-requisite / foundational course that all students must complete prior to or concurrently with their first IDDL-2 course:

EDT 8110 (Learning in a Digital World), previously known as EDL 7200 (Analysis of Teaching). This course is typically offered both Fall A-Term and Spring A-Term.

IDDL-2 Courses:

Fall Semester

A-Term: EDT 8210 – Applied Psychology Learning Theory for Digital Learning (3 credit hours)

B-Term: EDT 8220 – Instructional Design Concepts and Theories (3 credit hours)

Spring Semester

A-Term: EDT 8230 – Digital Scholarship of Teaching: Research Methods (3 credit hours)

B-Term: EDT 8240 – Digital Scholarship of Teaching: Literature Review (3 credit hours)

Summer Semester

A-Term: EDT 8250 – Digital Citizenship (3 credit hours)
