

## ACCESSING PILOT

*Pilot is the Learning Management System where all online courses are held.*

### Step #1 – Access Pilot

#### Option A

1. Go to WSU home page: **wright.edu**.
2. Click on **Pilot**.

#### Option B

Go directly to the Pilot site: **pilot.wright.edu**

### Step #2 – Log into Pilot

Enter your Username and Password\* where indicated and click “Login.”

### Step #3 – Locate Your Courses

In the left hand section of your MyPilot homepage, under the heading “My Courses,” you should see a list of the courses you are registered for. Click on a course to see the content for that course.

Please note: your courses will not show up in Pilot until your course instructor activates them. Most instructors do not activate their courses until the first day of the semester.

\*Campus Username and Password information was included in your initial letter from the WSU Graduate School. If you need this information again, contact the Help Desk at (937) 775-4827.

Note: this will be the user name that begins with a “W.” It will look something like this: w123abc.
