## Nurse Aide Training Requirement

### Pre-Licensure Students ONLY

As part of the requirements for starting the nursing program, you will need to successfully complete an Ohio Department of Health Nurse Aide Training course (minimum 75 hours).

How to Find Acceptable Nurse Aide Courses:

1. Visit this site: <https://odh.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/odh/know-our-programs/nurse-aide-training-and-competency-evaluation-program-natcep/resources/interestedinbecominganstna>
2. Select the download button for the “STNA Training Program Locator” attachment.

The attachment shows the facility-based (FB) and non-facility based (NFB) listings of the Nurse Aide Training and Competency Evaluation Program (NATCEP).

TIP: To search for specific counties or facilities, you can use the find command (Control+F).

The Ohio Department of Health certificate of successful course completion is required prior to beginning the first nursing course (NUR 2100).

It is highly encouraged that you take the State Nurse Aide State Registry examination upon completion of the program, which will place your name on the Ohio Nurse Aide Registry. This would permit you to work as a Nurse Aide in a health care facility. It is not required that you take the state test for entrance to the WSU nursing program.
