Listed below is a summary of the requirements graduate students must complete to earn an Ed.D. degree at Wright State University.

1. Complete a Program of Study form.
2. Complete the requirements for the graduate degree within ten calendar years.
3. Achieve a cumulative grade point/hour ratio of at least a 3.0 in all courses taken for graduate credit (no more than six hours of 'C' are acceptable).
4. No more than 50% non-degree hours may count towards degree.
5. Successfully complete the exit requirement.
6. Present one copy of an approved dissertation.

Student must be registered for at least one hour of graduate credit as designated by the department during the semester in which the successful defense of the dissertation is accomplished.
