## BLOOD BORNE PATHOGEN AND CLINICAL PASSPORT (GDAHA) TRAINING REQUIRED TRAINING MODULES

The required learning modules of Blood Borne Pathogens and the Clinical Passport (GDAHA) must be completed prior to the start of the nursing program and then <u>annually</u>.

- 2. Please read the training document and then complete the following:
  - 1. **Statement of Understanding** for the Clinical Passport document (Note: as of August 2022, there is no longer a quiz associated with the Clinical Passport)
  - 2. Take the quiz for the Blood Borne Pathogen training. You must achieve a 75% on the Blood Borne Pathogen quiz to generate the certificate of completion. You have unlimited attempts to obtain the 75%. After successfully passing the quiz, a **Certificate of Completion** (Pdf) will generate in the **AWARDS** tab at the top of the Pilot course. Your name and a date will be stamped on the certificate.
- 4. Load the Statement and Completion Certificate into the designated tabs in your Castle Branch program compliance account. You may also save a copy for your records.

Your annual renewal will be set one (1) year from the date on both documents.
