REQUIREMENTS FOR CARDIO PULMONAY RESUSITATION (CPR)

ALL STUDENTS

The required CPR is current certification for **Basic Life Support** (BLS for health care providers). The course must include single-rescuer, 2-person, AED, team basic life support with a focus on High-Quality CPR, team dynamics and *must have a face to face skill check component by a certified instructor*.

Note: On-line courses <u>only</u> will <u>not</u> be accepted for the nursing program.

The course must be taken directly through one of the following providers:

Military Students: AHA has recognized the *Military Training Network (MTN)* for Resuscitative Medicine Programs, thus the MTN provider cards are the equivalent of the corresponding AHA provider card and will be accepted.

Your CPR card (hard card or Ecard) must be submitted to your compliance account. No letters or certificates will be accepted, only the official CPR card is approved.
