The required learning modules of Blood Borne Pathogens and the Clinical Passport (GDAHA) must be completed prior to the start of the nursing program and then <u>annually</u>.

Log into Pilot and access the course is entitled *Training for the Nursing Program*. Be certain to perform the correct training year located under Table of Contents to the left of the main course page.

Please read the training documents and then complete the following:

- Take the quiz for the Blood Borne Pathogen training. You must achieve a 75% on the Blood Borne Pathogen quiz to generate the Certificate of Completion. You have unlimited attempts to obtain the 75%. After successfully passing the quiz, a *Certificate of Completion* (Pdf) will generate in the **AWARDS** tab at the top of the Pilot course. Your name and a date will be stamped on the certificate.
- 2 Read the Clinical Passport document and then sign/date the **Statement of Understanding**.
- 3. Submit the Completion Certificate of Completion (Pdf) for the Blood Borne Pathogens training and the Signed/Dated Statement of Understanding for the Clinical Passport into the designated tabs in your Castle Branch program compliance account. You may also save a copy for your records.

Your annual renewal will be set one (1) year from the date on both documents.
